

## Ogemaw County 4-17-2007

ORV's may be operated under 20 mph during daylight hours on the right shoulder of county roads in the following townships: Rose, Klacking, Foster, Rose City, Goodar, Cummings, Churchill, Hill, Logan and West Branch.

All DNR rules apply to ORVs, including safety equipment & age restrictions.

M-33 & M-55 are State Roads and ORVs are not allowed on them or their shoulders except to cross at right angles.

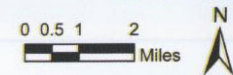
\$250 fine for any damage caused to roads or private property.

Forest roads, two-tracks, pipelines and snowmobile trails remain off-limits to ORVs.

Only county roads as depicted on this map and trails marked as open to ORVs are legal for travel.

A child must be 12 years old and have in their possession a valid ORV Safety Certificate to operate an ORV on the shoulder of a county road. Operators of ages 12-16 must possess a valid ORV safety certificate and be under direct adult visual supervision.
